In recent years, he studied food waste and food systems sustainability taking a behavioral perspective based on a variety of methodologies including surveys, focus groups, experiments and modelling. He is widely engaged in third mission activities with the aim to engage citizen in food waste prevention and in the adoption of healthy lifestyles. Among his activities he founded Last Minute Market, an academic spin off - University of Bologna (2007) aimed to food and non-food waste prevention and recovery to benefit charities, the Italian Zero Waste Campaign (Campagna Spreco Zero, 2010), the Waste Watcher Italian Observatory (2013) and the Waste Watcher International Observatory on Food and Sustainability (2021).
